

SLN Marines – US Navy continue post relief missions



US Navy personnel who arrived onboard USS 'Lake Erie', in coordination with Sri Lanka Navy Marines provided post humanitarian assistance and disaster relief support activities in the flood affected areas in western and southern provinces.

Accordingly, under the humanitarian assistance commenced on 12th June, they

cleaned 4 schools enabling students to continue their education smoothly. Moreover, 324 wells were cleaned providing drinking water facilities for the public and 4 bunds were renovated which were damaged due to flash floods recently.

The ship is due to set sail from the Colombo harbour on June 25, upon completion of a series of post relief missions.
